This privacy notice discloses the privacy practices for www.westcoastsurrogacy.com ("West Coast").

This privacy notice applies solely to information collected by this website except where stated otherwise. It will notify you of the following:

- What information we collect;
- With whom it is shared;

We collect marketing referral data throughout all your visits to our website. Data pertaining to our marketing campaigns across different platforms is stored in a cookie and upon completion of a contact form, the data is tied to your account. We do not sell, trade, or rent this information to anyone and only use it to identify effective marketing efforts and make business decisions.

With your explicit consent, we may contact you via email in the future to tell you about services, notifications from our surrogacy application database, or changes to this privacy policy.
